Platelets release thromboplastin which interacts with calcium ions to convert prothrombin in the plasma into thrombin which acts as an enzyme to combine fibrinogen elements together making fibrin. Fibrin then sticks to the surfaces of the blood vessels forming a net that traps formed elements which creates a clot.

Ch. 12 Blood. Blood vessel spasm, damaged/broken vessels stimulate muscle tissue in the walls of the blood vessels to contract. This slows/stop blood flow, lasts for several minuets. Also, platelets release serotonin, a vasoconstrictor which maintains the muscle even longer.
